“I typically call people shortly after we are notified about the diagnosis,” Pat said. “Calls are then made to people anywhere from once a week, month, or quarter depending on how things are going.” She makes suggestions, answers questions, and offers much needed encouragement. Pat remains in contact, but calls less often, as people get a handle on their condition. They can call her as needed.
